## How to Search the Directory


1. Log into the site. If you are not yet a member, click the blue Not a Member button or the register button in the upper right hand corner of the screen.



2. To begin click into one of the six **Search Tool** Boxes below and checking any of the desired expertise categories .



3. Clicking on the Expertise Regions section, you may click on +show map for a map of the regions.



4. Or you can simply search by a Members Name, Organization, and/or State. The Fields will auto-fill as you type, simply select the name desired that shows up in the box.




### How to Add your expertise and additional member information to the directory
